



## HCV Cancer Alliance Programme Update to Stakeholders – 10 November 2017

As part of the Programme Communications and Stakeholder Engagement Strategy the programme team is keen on keeping the stakeholders in the system well informed on the latest developments. We will do this by sending brief updates systematically to all those involved in delivering the best possible care in cancer services within the Alliance footprint.

This week the programme has:

- Attended the Delivering Transformation in Cancer outcomes workshop held by the National Cancer Team in London;
- Continued to monitor and support the delivery of the 62 day waiting standard;
- Sent new Term of Reference for Programme Board, System Performance and Monitoring (SPAM) Group and Programme Executive to be included for consideration at the next Programme Board on 13 November 2017;
- Had the Treatments and Pathways and Awareness and Early Diagnosis Delivery Board meetings on 8 November and 10 November respectively;
- Agreed with NHS England and NHS Improvement a more joined up approach to how we will work together;
- Submitted Quarterly Report to NHS England with projections and assumptions in relation to performance on 62 day target and progress on implementing transformation plans utilising transformation funding;
- Started preparations for a quarterly programme assurance meeting with NHS Improvement and NHS England, which will take place on 15 November 2017.
