

# Health and Social Care in Hull and East Riding

## HEALTH CARE

- **Hull University Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust** serves patients in Hull and East Yorkshire, employing over 8,000 staff. The Trust operates two main sites; Hull Royal Infirmary and Castle Hill Hospital. [www.hey.nhs.uk](http://www.hey.nhs.uk)
- **Humber Teaching NHS Foundation Trust** delivers Community Services in the Hull & East Riding areas providing community and inpatient mental health services, community services (including therapies), learning disability services and healthy lifestyle support. Also specialist services for children, including physiotherapy, speech and language therapy and support for children and young people and their families who are experiencing emotional or mental health difficulties. - **City Health Care Partnership** provide over 50 diverse services in community settings which include health visiting, palliative care and school nursing. <http://www.chcpcic.org.uk>
- **Primary Care Services** are known as GP Practices/Doctors surgeries and provide the first point of contact in the healthcare system. The Primary care team has clinical and non-clinical members including doctors, nurses, pharmacists, paramedics, as well as Practice Managers, receptionists, medical secretaries, prescription clerks, referral secretaries and data analysts. There are Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) in Hull [www.hullccg.nhs.uk](http://www.hullccg.nhs.uk) and East Riding [www.eastridingofyorkshireccg.nhs.uk](http://www.eastridingofyorkshireccg.nhs.uk) that support GP Practices in Hull and East Riding.
- **Haxby Advanced Teaching Practice** provides patient care at GP surgeries across Hull & York, covering 11 sites and around 60,000 registered patients.
