

# Health and Social Care in North and North East Lincolnshire

## HEALTH CARE

- **Northern Lincolnshire and Goole NHS Foundation Trust** provides a range of hospital-based services to a population of more than 400,000 people across North and North East Lincolnshire and East Riding of Yorkshire. They employ around 6,500 staff and operate from three hospital sites Diana, Princess of Wales, Scunthorpe General and Goole and District Hospital. The Trust also provides community services across North and North East Lincolnshire, including district nursing, physiotherapy and psychology, podiatry and specialist dental services. - **NAVIGO Health and Social Care Community Interest Company** is a non-profit making organisation providing all local mental health and associated services in North East Lincolnshire. Navigo provide transport services, triage and medical advice provided remotely, treatment of disease, disorder or injury, diagnostic and screening procedures and assessment or medical treatment for persons detained under Mental Health Act 1983.
