HEALTH CARE

- **York Teaching Hospital NHS Foundation Trust** manage eight hospital sites (York, Scarborough, Bridlington, Malton, Selby, Easingwold, White Cross and St Helens rehabilitation centres in York) and have around 9,000 staff working across the whole community. www.yorkhospitals.nhs.uk
